- 3. Lumbar laminectomy and ulnar nerve release surgery required after plaintiff was involved in a commercial truck collision in Westmoreland County, Virginia: Settled for \$725,000
- 4. Plaintiff's stopped vehicle in traffic was rear-ended by a tractor trailer that caused the plaintiff's vehicle to spin around on the Interstate 95 exit ramp in Fairfax, Virginia. Plaintiff sustained a mild <u>traumatic brain injury</u>, post-traumatic stress disorder, and left wrist fracture. Settled for \$600.000.00
- 5. Dog Bite, Young woman attacked by a Belgian Malanois: Settled for \$225,000.00
- 6. Plaintiff travelling in a tractor trailer on interstate 295 in Prince George County was struck by Defendant's tractor trailer at a high rate of speed. Plaintiff sustained a shoulder injury that required shoulder surgery: Settled for \$660,000.00
